

2 Corinthians 5:1-10. (HCSB)

5 For we know that if our earthly house, a tent, is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.

2 And, in fact, we groan in this one, longing to put on our house from heaven, **3** since, when we are clothed, we will not be found naked.

4 Indeed, we groan while we are in this tent, burdened as we are, because we do not want to be unclothed but clothed, so that mortality may be swallowed up by life. **5** And the One who prepared us for this very purpose is God, who gave us the Spirit as a down payment.

6 So, we are always confident and know that while we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord.

7 For we walk by faith, not by sight, **8** and we are confident and satisfied to be out of the body and at home with the Lord.

9 Therefore, whether we are at home or away, we make it our aim to be pleasing to Him. **10** For we must all appear before the tribunal of Christ, so that each may be repaid for what he has done in the body, whether good or worthless.
