

THE CONFORMITY CYCLE

Romans 8:19-21 (HCSB)

19 For the creation eagerly waits with anticipation for **God's sons to be revealed**. **20** For the creation was subjected to futility—not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it—in the hope **21** that the creation itself will also be set free from the **bondage of corruption into the glorious freedom of God's children**.

Romans 8:28-29 (HCSB)

28 We know that all things work together for the good of those who love God: those who are called **according to His purpose**. **29** For those He foreknew He also predestined to be **conformed to the image of His Son**, so that He would be the firstborn among many brothers.

Psalms 42:1-2 (HCSB)

1 As a deer longs for streams of water, so **I long for You, God**.
2 I thirst for God, the living God.
When can I come and appear before God?

Psalms 63:1-2 (HCSB)

1 God, You are my God; **I eagerly seek You. I thirst for You**;
my body faints for You in a land that is dry, desolate, and without water.
2 So I gaze on You in the sanctuary/ to see Your strength and Your glory.

Exodus 33:18 (HCSB)

18 Then Moses said, **“Please, let me see Your glory.”**

Philippians 3:7-8 (HCSB)

7 But everything that was a gain to me, I have considered to be a loss because of Christ. **8** More than that, I also consider everything to be a loss **in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord**. Because of Him I have suffered the loss of all things and consider them filth, so that I may gain Christ

Romans 1:11-12 (HCSB)

11 For I want very much to **see** you, so I may **impart** to you some spiritual gift to **strengthen** you, **12** that is, to be mutually **encouraged** by each other's faith, both yours and mine.
