Ezekiel 36:16-18 (HCSB)

16 The word of the Lord came to me: **17** "Son of man, while the house of Israel lived in their land, they defiled it with their conduct and actions. Their behavior before Me was like menstrual impurity. **18** So I poured out My wrath on them because of the blood they had shed on the land, and because they had defiled it with their idols.

Ezekiel 36:19 (HCSB)

19 I dispersed them among the nations, and they were scattered among the countries. I judged them according to their conduct and actions.

Isaiah 59:1-2 & 14 (HCSB)

1 Indeed, the Lord's hand is not too short to save,
and His ear is not too deaf to hear.
2 But your iniquities have built barriers
between you and your God,
and your sins have made Him hide His face from you
so that He does not listen. . .
14 Justice is turned back,
and righteousness stands far off.
For truth has stumbled in the public square,
and honesty cannot enter.

Ezekiel 36:20 (HCSB)

20 When they came to the nations where they went, they profaned My holy name, because it was said about them, 'These are the people of Yahweh, yet they had to leave His land in exile.'

Ezekiel 36:28-30 (HCSB)

28 Then you will live in the land that I gave your fathers; you will be My people, and I will be your God. **29** I will save you from all your uncleanness. I will summon the grain and make it plentiful, and will not bring famine on you. **30** I will also make the fruit of the trees and the produce of the field plentiful, so that you will no longer experience reproach among the nations on account of famine.
