

TERMINATION BECOMES INAUGURATION

Matthew 21:12-13 (HCSB)

12 Jesus went into the temple complex and drove out all those buying and selling in the temple. He overturned the money changers' tables and the chairs of those selling doves. **13** And He said to them, "It is written, My house will be called a house of prayer. But you are making it a den of thieves!"

Matthew 26:3-4 (HCSB)

3 Then the chief priests and the elders of the people assembled in the palace of the high priest, who was called Caiaphas, **4** and they conspired to arrest Jesus in a treacherous way and kill Him.

1 Corinthians 2:7-8 (HCSB)

7 On the contrary, we speak God's hidden wisdom in a mystery, a wisdom God predestined before the ages for our glory. **8** None of the rulers of this age knew this wisdom, for if they had known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

Hebrews 10:9-10 (HCSB)

9 He then says, See, I have come to do Your will. He takes away the first to establish the second. **10** By this will of God, we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once and for all.

Matthew 23:37-38 (HCSB)

37 "Jerusalem, Jerusalem! She who kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to her. How often I wanted to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, yet you were not willing! **38** See, your house is left to you desolate.

Matthew 24:1-2 (HCSB)

24 As Jesus left and was going out of the temple complex, His disciples came up and called His attention to the temple buildings. **2** Then He replied to them, "Don't you see all these things? I assure you: Not one stone will be left here on another that will not be thrown down!"

Hebrews 8:13 (HCSB)

13 By saying, a new covenant, He has declared that the first is old. And what is old and aging is about to disappear.
